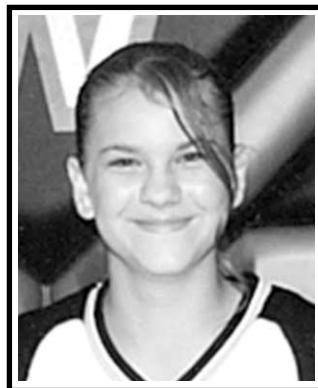


# Kids with character
