PURPOSE:

Akron Children's Hospital in partnership with the Akron Beacon Journal Newspaper in Education Department will recognize a Kid With Character every week among area students. This recognition has been established to recognize outstanding young citizens for bettering their neighborhoods, schools, and communities.

ELIGIBILITY:

Any child, ages 9-18, living in Summit, Portage, Wayne, Stark, and Medina Counties is eligible.

NOMINATIONS:

Any adult, club, community organization, church, employer, teacher or school may submit nominations. There is no limit to the number of nominations any one person or group may make. All nominations must be submitted on the official nomination form and must have the proper signatures (two adults, one of which must be the parent or guardian). A picture of the student must also be included.

SELECTION:

Each week one nomination will be chosen for recognition as a Kid With Character. Selections will be made by staff members of the Newspaper in Education Department at the Akron Beacon Journal, based on complete nomination forms and verification of information on the form. Every Tuesday, a child will be featured in the Akron Beacon Journal as a Kid With Character.
