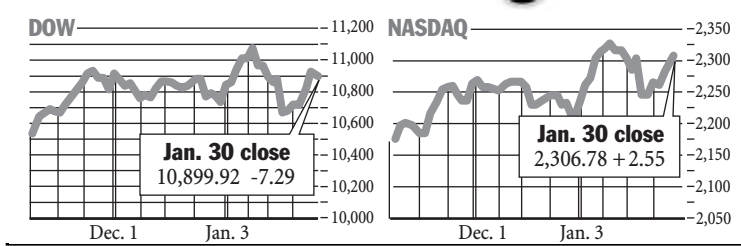

Kraft says it will cut 8,000 more jobs

Kraft Foods Inc., the nation's largest food manufacturer, said Monday it would eliminate 8,000 more jobs, or about 8 percent of its work force, and close up to 20 production plants as it broadens an ongoing restructuring effort.

Kraft said the cuts would save an additional \$700 million in annual costs, atop a targeted \$450 million in savings it already had hoped to achieve through a restructuring that began in January 2004.

Northfield, Ill.-based Kraft said it intends to close plants in Broadmeadows, Victoria, in Australia and Hoover, Ala., but did not announce the other facilities it plans to close.

Steris to move 450 jobs to Mexico

Steris Corp., a maker of sanitizing lotions and soaps, said Monday that it is closing manufacturing operations of a Pennsylvania plant and moving 450 jobs to Mexico by the summer of 2007.

The plant in Erie, Pa., makes sterilization equipment and employs 670 people, including 450 in manufacturing. The rest of the jobs, which serve in a variety of functions, will stay.

Mentor-based Steris said it expects the move to save it \$20 million a year. CEO Les C. Vinney said the decision was made because of lower-cost foreign competitors, and the Erie plant was Steris' most expensive. Shares fell 45 cents to close at \$26.45.

Flight attendants OK cuts at Continental

Flight attendants for Continental Airlines Inc. have approved an agreement that calls for \$72 million in labor concessions, according to the airline and the union.

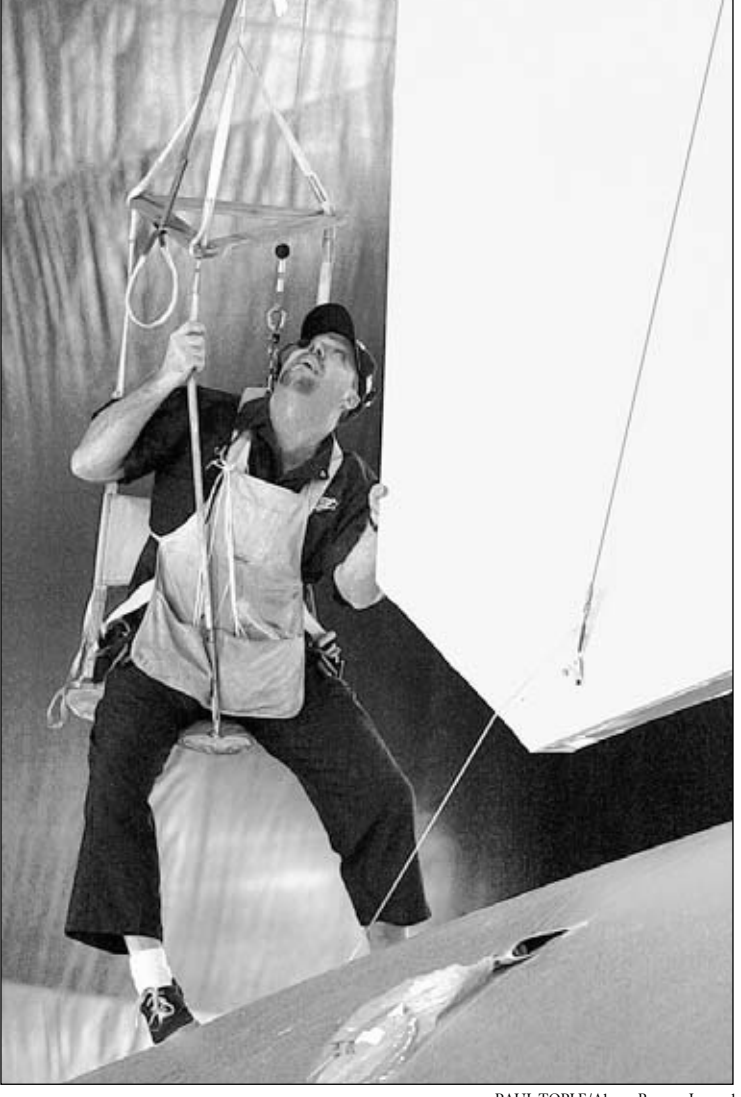
Continental said it was told late Sunday that the deal was approved after flight attendants voted in Houston, Cleveland and Newark, N.J. Union leaders were expected to certify the results today.

Other groups, including pilots and mechanics, had already approved \$418 million in concessions. When added to \$10 million from international employees, the flight attendants agreement will fulfill the company's goal set in late 2004 to cut annual labor costs by \$500 million, said spokeswoman Julie King.

Shares rose 95 cents, or 5.1 percent, to close at \$19.44.

Wayne Savings reports net earnings

Wayne Savings Bancshares Inc., the stock holding company parent of Wayne Savings Community Bank, reported net earnings of \$171,000 or 5 cents per diluted share for the third quarter ending Dec. 31, compared to net earnings of \$403,000 or 11 cents per diluted share for the year-ago quarter. The decrease was due primarily to \$225,000 of incremental and nonrecurring charges. Wayne Savings Community Bank has banking locations in Wooster, Ashland, Millersburg, Rittman, Lodi, North Canton and Creston.

In the meantime, they will place a GPS antenna and beacon lights on the envelope. In addition, the crew will tighten the cables that hold the gondola to the bottom of the envelope.

"Once that's all done, we go back to the fins," Babbo said. Tensioning the fin cables and lacing parts of the fins to the envelope will take several more days, he
