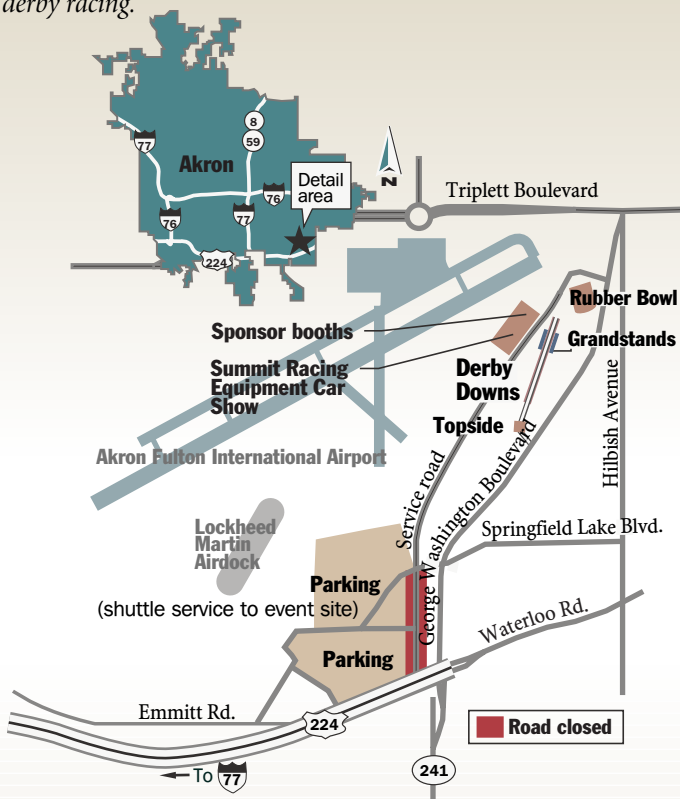


# Derby Day 2006

Children from throughout the world converge Saturday on Akron for the running of the All-American Soap Box Derby — the World Series of derby racing.



### Getting there

Derby Downs is on George Washington Boulevard between the Akron Fulton International Airport and the University of Akron's Rubber Bowl. From Akron, go south on Interstate 77, then east on U.S. 224. Turn left on George Washington Boulevard, left onto Springfield Lake Boulevard and police will direct you to parking.

### Tickets

Admission to the derby is \$5 per person. Advance tickets are available at all Holland Oil stores. Parking is free and shuttle transportation is provided. One ticket is good for all Friday and Saturday events.

### Race day schedule

**7 to 10 a.m.** - Kiwanis pancake breakfast

**8:30 a.m.** - Opening ceremonies

**9 a.m. to 4 p.m.** - Hall of fame open

**9 a.m.** - Race begins

**6 p.m.** - Salute to champions

**8 p.m.** - Awards presentation (at EJ Thomas Hall, downtown Akron)

Racing is suspended for rain, but can resume as soon as it clears. If the day is a washout, the derby could conclude on Sunday.
